# FRANCE BURGUNDY

Burgundy, a revered French wine region, specializes in Pinot Noir and Chardonnay. Its subregions include Côte d'Or (Côte de Nuits & Côte de Beaune), Côte Chalonnaise, and Mâconnais. Chablis, an isolated pocket of limestone hills in north-western Burgundy, produces distinct white wines, set apart from central Burgundy. The climate is chiefly continental, characterized by short summers and cool winters.

# ITALY



### Rose Wine

It is actually the oldest type of wine ever made. Rose wine is made with red wine grapes, in a similar manner to red wine but with reduced time fermenting the grape skins. The reduced skin contact gives the desired pink colour and a lighter flavour than of a red wine.

It is typically blended with variety of different wine grapes. It can be also single varietal wine made from only one type of grape. The common grape varieties to produce a rose wine are Syrah, Cinsault, Mourvedre, Tibouren, Carignan, Pinot Noir and Cabernet Sauvignon.
